- Approve November meeting minutes

  - Members voted November minutes were approved!

#### 3. Treasurer's Report - Lauren Schleicher

- Current budget by the numbers:
  - o Budgeted Expenses: \$52,680.00
  - o Actual Expenses YTD: \$17,868.43
  - o Projected Income: \$52,680.00
  - o Actual Income YTD: \$14,581.18
  - Needed to cover budgeted expenses: \$38,098.82
- Income Updates
  - o Box Tops check is in: \$612.90
  - Amazon Smile deposit in mid November: \$62.56
  - Theater Night Out in February more info. in "Upcoming Event" section

- Website Update
  - Now including newsletters
  - Looking for a Website Chair
    - Estimated 10 hours/month
    - All work to be done from home; own time
    - Molly Carruthers volunteered!
      - Lauren and Molly will connect
- Potential Upcoming Expenses more discussion in "Open Forum"
  - o Spinwheel copies
    - Updated spinwheel to be easier to read white text
    - Suggestion from Katie Jones to add the PTA Logo/catchphrase to the heading
    - Use for informational handouts
    - 2500 copies = \$225 approx (.09 each)
  - Magnet Reorder for future use with incoming kids
    - $\blacksquare$  2000 = \$380, 2500 = \$400
    - What will ensure we have enough for future use?
    - Spend the money now or wait and order in smaller batches?
    - Very few currently on hand
